

MILOŠ, guitar, plays Bach, Albeniz, Villa-Lobos, and more

One of today's most electrifying guitarists, MILOS brings new dynamism and range to 92NY's celebrated Art of the Guitar series.

Born in Montenegro and now based in London, MILOŠ has been selling out concerts throughout Europe with his charismatic artistry and repertoire that takes him from Bach to Spanish masterworks, global pop, and beyond. His recording of Rodrigo concertos with the London Philharmonic and Yannick Nézet-Séguin had The Times (London) labeling him "The King of Araniuez." His Beatles tribute album Blackbird featured artists from Tori Amos to Steven Isserlis to Sérgio Assad - each of them drawn to MILOŠ' artistry and his world view of the classical guitar. On this program: Bach' s Chaconne, Spanish masterworks, the New York premiere of an homage to Andrés Segovia by French composer Matthias Duplessy, Tōru Takemitsu's exquisite guitar arrangement of Harold Arlen's "Over the Rainbow," and more.
